2024 Primary Election Endorsement Results WA 37th Legislative District Democrats • June, 2024

The 37th LD Democrats employ ranked-choice voting to select our endorsed candidates in races where multiple choices are moved for endorsement. This process involves winnowing down the field through progressive rounds of candidate elimination and vote reallocation. Within each individual race the first set of numbers reflects the initial vote count. This is followed by subsequent round(s) of elimination, as needed, and results after vote reallocation. The threshold for endorsement is 60%.

About Vote Reallocation

During the first-round vote allocation, the choice with the lowest number of votes is eliminated. In the U.S. Representative, Congressional District 9 race above, for example, that was No Endorsement.

For the second-round vote allocation in that race, No Endorsement has been eliminated. The additional choices from those voters have been reallocated to the remaining two candidates. (Note that it was not required to vote for all options.) For purposes of the calculated vote percentage the voting universe is based on the first-round vote count, 124 in this case, and does not change.

For the third-round vote allocation, the choice with the lower number of votes (Melissa Chaudhry) has been eliminated. Of her voters, those who listed Adam Smith as an additional choice had those votes for him reallocated to him.
