The amended resolution passed 48 to 2.

It was then agreed that we will send the resolution to The Seattle Times, The Stranger, The Facts, The Capitol Hill blog, The Burner, and The Seattle Emerald.

Robert Stevens asked that we start using the money granted by the state to meet certain goals about getting members and PCO more active. The chair is working with the state on this.
