There are variety of substitutes:

I was rare K-12 any job	Only certain subjects	1/2 day is all that's available
Work 6-12	Only certain number days	Work only certain days week
Work 9-12	Only certain schools	Work only 1 or 2 grade levels
Work k-5	Only certain teachers	Some districts reduce hours of some assignments

### Data on School Districts in State of Washington

- There is 308 SD in state and state-tribal education compact schools which report to SEBB
- There are 159 class B SD with 200 or less high school student
- My high school, The Brewster Bears, was a B with an enrollment at or less 200 with teachers 12 HS + 16 K-8 for total 28. It would be impossible to work 630 hours in a district this small
- Only 62 SD in the state that are large enough to have enough assignments for a substitute to work 630 hours
- Two SD I know of try to prevent substitutes from working 830 hours Kenwick SD and Mose Lake SD

### Seattle SD Data 2024-2025

- Number of Subs 1703
- Number of Subs working 630 hrs. 360
- Percent of Seattle subs working 630 hrs. 21%

This does mean there are 360 substitutes that will be affected by this change in SEBB

- Not all subs that qualify for SEBB enroll
- Some subs have been SEBB for multiple years
- Some subs this second year for SEBB. They start will third year with SEBB
